


**PUBLIC HEARING

RESOLUTION NO. 18-10

A RESOLUTION SETTING TAX RATES
AND LEVYING TAXES FOR 2018

BE IT RESOLVED by the Fiscal Court of Bullitt County, Kentucky, pursuant to KRS 68.100, that the tax levies per \$100.00 of assessed valuation for 2018 are as follows:

Real Estate	9.6
Tangible Personal Property	9.6
Public Service Companies (Real Estate)	9.6
Public Service Companies (Personal)	9.6
Distilled Spirits	9.6
Motor Vehicles	15.0
Watercraft	15.0
Local Deposits Franchise	25.0

Said levies are made for the purpose of raising revenue to repair and maintain county roads and public buildings, to provide emergency and law enforcement services, to pay salaries of county employees and officials, and to pay all proper charges and legal demands against the county.

This Resolution shall become effective upon passage and publication.

Adopted this 24th day of September, 2018, at a special meeting of the Bullitt County Fiscal Court.
